YOU Will BE ASSESSED FOR COVID-19 RISK.

Do you now have:	YES	NO	MILD or RARE
FEVER over 100 (usually over 101)			
A dry cough (or maybe modest sputum production)			
Fatigue			
Shortness of breath			
Loss of smell or taste (Note: zinc lozenges can also cause this)			
Personal, direct exposure to known COVID-19 patient			
Runny nose			
Weeping eyes			
Dripping congested sinuses			
Vomiting or diarrhea			
Muscle ache			
Headache			
Chills			
Sore throat			
The top box is likely COVID-19 IF prevalent in the community			
The middle box is likely URI (cold), or AGE (gastroenteritis), or some other "crud" of the week.			
The bottom box is too non-specific to help differentiate. Consider Strep Throat or Influenza.			

Some studies have suggested 50% of the people may be spreading the virus without any symptoms at all. We cannot know the truth because the U.S. cannot accomplish wide-spread, unrestricted testing.
